

Past simple passive

Remember

- past simple passive is formed with the past tense of the verb *be* (i.e. *was* and *were*) + past participle.
*The first real aeroplane was **built** in 1903.*
- we use *by* + noun when we want to say who does the action.
*The first real aeroplane was flown **by** Orville and Wilbur Wright.*
