## Remember

Short adjectives + *est.* *tall* – *tallest*

Short adjectives ending in one consonant double last letter + *est.* *hot* – *hottest*

Long adjectives (more than 2 syllables) = *most* + adjective: *most amazing*

Be careful of irregular adjectives e.g. *good*.
