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## PET *INSPIRATION* MAPPING DOCUMENT

Levels 1-3 of *Inspiration* cover most of the PET syllabus (in a very few instances an area is dealt with in *Inspiration* 4) as well as develop the four skills of reading, writing, listening and speaking needed for the exam. In addition the Student's Books and the Workbooks have many exercises that follow a similar format to questions in the PET exam. The following document maps the PET syllabus to *Inspiration*. After completing *Inspiration* 3, we recommend students go on to use an exam preparatory course such as *Ready for PET* (Macmillan) for specific exam practice.
